JOB OVERVIEW:

Eleazar African Foundation is an educational and counseling resource for vulnerable children and youth in Lira, Uganda. We are a small community-based initiative who seeks to love and care for our community by providing learning and healing opportunities to its children and youth. We support the development of their academic interests and empower each child to discover their own skills, talents, and abilities. Furthermore, we address the underlying challenges and struggles that have contributed to their vulnerabilities through individual, family, and group counseling. We are seeking a dedicated and committed Cook to come alongside our team to provide nutritious and balanced meals for healthy development.

RESPONSIBILITIES AND DUTIES:

1. Missional expectations: Being a cook is a missional vocation and calling from God. Serve the Lord by putting the needs of our vulnerable children and youth above your own. Respect and love every person who enters the Eleazar Center. Demonstrate an active, growing faith and exhibit godly character.
2. Food preparation responsibilities: Cook and prepare breakfast and lunch for children, staff, volunteers, and guests of the Eleazar Center (approx. 65 people daily).
3. Kitchen responsibilities: Maintain cleanliness and hygiene in food preparation and serve food hot and on time. Wash all saucepans, cooking utensils, serving ware, and sanitize the kitchen daily. Discard all food scraps properly.
4. Meal planning responsibilities: Collaborate with the hospitality team to plan the menu and budget, purchase food items, and provide accountability for food purchased and consumed daily. Source, arrange, and prepare firewood or charcoal for daily use.
5. Stewardship responsibilities: Steward all allocated resources in an honest, responsible, integrous, and trustworthy manner. Use resources economically and efficiently.
